

## **Additional items for behaviour policy during the pandemic – temporary adjustment June 2020**

It is vital for the health of all pupils and staff, that children follow H&S instructions (to the best of their abilities and understanding) and that any wilful reluctance to adhere to the instructions is swiftly acted upon by staff. Pupils may be reminded, reprimanded or given a sanction for \***deliberate failure to:**

- Follow any altered routines for arrival or departure from the school site
- Follow school instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitising
- Follow instructions on who pupils can socialise with at school
- Move around the school following specific instructions (for example, one-way systems, out of bounds areas, queuing, lunch routines)
- Following expectations about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it')
- Tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- Follow rules about sharing any equipment or other items including drinking bottles
- Follow clear rules about coughing or spitting at or towards any other person

*\*Staff who know the specific needs of identified pupils well, will judge whether actions are deliberate attempts to defy safety rules or genuine inability to follow them/misunderstanding of them and give support accordingly. Ratified by governors 16/6/20*
